LANCASTER HABITAT RESTORE 2014 PARTNER OF THE YEAR

*Award Presented at Lancaster Area Habitat for Humanity's Celebration Dinner October 6*

MANHEIM, PA – On Monday, October 6, Pleasant View Retirement Community was recognized as the 2014 Habitat ReStore Partner of the Year during Lancaster Area Habitat for Humanity's 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Celebration Dinner and Silent Auction, held at the Lancaster County Convention Center.

Over the past year, Pleasant View Retirement Community embarked on extensive renovations to its Residential Living apartments, cottages and common areas to offer upgraded features and added amenities. Pleasant View turned to Lancaster Area Habitat for Humanity to find a home for gently used building materials, fixtures and furniture set to be replaced, but still in good condition. Through their partnership, these items are donated to the Lancaster Area Habitat for Humanity's ReStore, a non-profit business specializing in the resale of new and gently used building materials and supplies to the public. Habitat ReStore is then able to provide additional funding to support Habitat for Humanity's house-building goals, expand opportunities to serve a broader base of the low-income community by providing low-cost materials, and provide good stewardship of sustainable resources in the community.

Nancy Cullen, Donations Manager for Habitat ReStore remarked, "This has been a marriage/partnership made in heaven." Due to Pleasant View's continued donations and support, the ReStore has seen an increase in revenue as well as the ability to offer high quality items. The partnership has also opened doors for the ReStore to build new relationships with additional retirement communities throughout Lancaster County.
